CHAPTER 1

ELECTRICITY, WATER AND SEWAGE

13-102. Fluoridation of water.

13-101. Board of Public Utilities. The City Commission of the City of Paris, Tennessee, is hereby authorized to create The Paris Board of Public Utilities by a resolution duly adopted at a regular or special meeting of the governing body in accordance with the authority granted under Title 6, Chapter 15 of Tennessee Code Annotated, to be composed of five (5) members, appointed by said resolution, organized and with such powers and duties with respect to the control and operation of the municipal electric system as are authorized and prescribed in Title 6, Chapter 15, of the Tennessee Code Annotated. The board is also given such powers and duties with respect to the control and operation of the municipal water and sewage system as are authorized and prescribed for the Board of Waterworks and Sewage Commissioners in Title 6, Chapter 14 of the Tennessee Code Annotated. The management of the electric, water and sewage systems is hereby expressly declared not to be a responsibility of the city manager. However, the Board of Public Utilities shall see that all responsible utility officials cooperate and coordinate closely with the city manager and keep him informed in writing, of plans and operations which will, or may, affect other city departments or operations. It is specifically ordained and provided that any and all the provisions of Section 6-1501 through Section 6-1543, Tennessee Code Annotated is hereby incorporated into this ordinance and made a part hereof as fully and completely as if recited and stated verbatim herein. 13-102. Fluoridation of water. The Board of Public Utilities is hereby authorized and directed to add fluorine to the public water supply in accordance with such plans as the state department of health shall approve as adequate for the fluoridation of such water supply. The city shall pay for the necessary equipment and chemicals. (Ord. #260, 01/21/52).
